Many of these children have never received a gift, and this is a great project you can do together with your children or grandchildren.

For the next 5 weeks, you can pick up empty shoeboxes in the LCA lobby. Each box contains a label and shopping ideas. Simply decide how many boxes you want to pack, choose the gender and age of the child you want to receive the box, and start shopping. There is a suggested donation of \$9 shipping for each returned shoebox, and with new special labels, you can easily pay shipping online and track your box to its final destination. **Return all packed shoeboxes (with label affixed) to LCA office by Friday, Nov 20.**

Last year, LCA families donated 56 shoeboxes that went to children in refugee camps in Columbia (S. America), and to islands in the South Pacific. Thank you for your past support, and we hope you will join us again this year.
